

**Shaw's Bounty Association's Board of Directors
Discussion in Preparation for Upcoming Storm Season
September 4, 2018**

The Board concluded that Glynn County does an admirable job of preparing for, communicating about, and cleaning up after tropical storms. With this in mind, the Board decided to offer residents a list of resources where storm information can be found.

The board also decided to encourage Association members to use Shaw's Bounty's Nextdoor website to share information among neighbors during a storm. The Nextdoor address is https://nextdoor.com/neighborhood_feed/. Currently, 43 of our 75 households (57 percent) are members of Nextdoor. We have 62 members in total with some households having multiple members.
